It's not hard, and it's really rewarding knowing you are helping those who *truly* need your help. In addition, you are sharing about the Bread of Life Rescue Mission to others who may not know about them and what they do.

Be part of the "YA GOTTA HAVE HEART" Competition. We hope your heart will bring you to the challenge. Please mark your registration yes if you will help us reach our fundraising goal of **\$25,000** for this year's event. No minimum amount is required. Individuals or groups can compete in this FUNdraising event.

With the donations you collect by asking your friends and family to contribute, take a look below at what the Bread of Life Rescue Mission can provide to those who so desperately need your help. These can be used as fundraising goals, but are not required fundraising levels. Any amount you can collect is greatly appreciated.



\$10	Every \$10 will purchase \$20 of food to be provided to give out at the Food Box Distribution 3 times a week.
\$60	\$60 will provide the cost of 1 month bus pass for 1 person seeking rehabilitation.
\$100	\$100 will provide the cost of 1 full tank of gas for the produce bus to pick up food to feed those who are poor and hungry.
\$250	\$250 provides for the cost of kitchen supplies for 1 week.
\$500	\$500 provides the cost for one week of case management services for 50 people wanting to improve their lives.
\$1,500	\$1,500 pays the cost of 1 weeks rent for the entire Bread of Life Rescue Mission's facility

Types of Donations that can be included in the FUNdraising Competition:

Cash/Checks and Gift Cards - Bring the donations you have collected to the event with you. These can be in the form of checks, cash, gift cards to Costco or Smart & Final, Home Depot or Lowes, Bus Passes, Fast Food Restaurants, Walmart, Target, or other cards the Rescue Mission can use to help lighten the load in providing services.

“Crafter’s Corner”- Bring your gently used craft items marked, individually bagged and ready for the committee to sell at the “Crafter’s Corner” aka Garage Sale, which will be held at the event site! Everyone wins here – You can donate your gently used craft items and clean out your craft area at home, someone else at the event can purchase your items and get a bargain, and the Rescue Mission receives the cash. **You** will receive the credit of your sold donated items and it will be added to the total of your fundraising efforts. It’s a win-win for everyone!! These amounts will be added to the total of your donations at the event. (Items not sold can be picked up at the end of the event by the seller, or donated to the Rescue Mission to sell in their Restore store)

Top Fundraiser Awards:

The event committee will be awarding some awesome and wonderful “Thank You” gifts at the event in the following categories:

Individual - This is the person with the most total combination of cash, checks, gift cards and donated craft items sold in the Crafter’s Corner exceeds all other individually submitted donations. (**see note below) They will be crowned the **Queen of Hearts** and will have their choice of a weekend at the Oasis Resort in Palm Desert, provided by Palmer’s Playmates Preschool OR a weekend at the Apples Bed and Breakfast Inn, located in Big Bear. The Princess of Hearts (runner up) will receive whichever gift weekend the Queen does not select.

Group- This is the table with the most total combination of cash, checks, gift cards, donated craft items sold in the Crafter’s Corner and exceeds all other group submitted donations. A wonderful Thank you gift will be given to each participant o the group.
